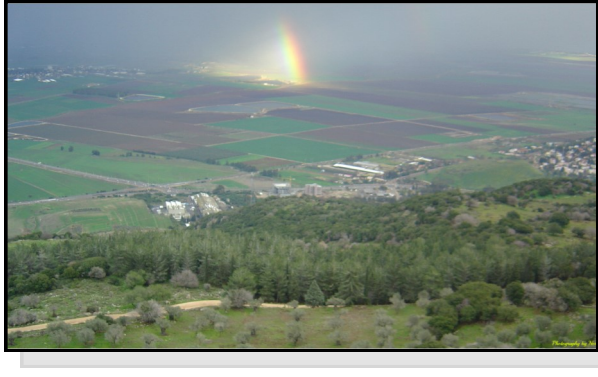
TRANSFERS - Transportation of passengers and luggage is provided on arrival and departure from airports to and from hotels and is included in the tour cost when traveling with the main tour party.

OUR ITINERARY

FEB 18 WED DEPART THE USA

Depart the United States on Delta Airlines.

FEB 19 THU ARRIVE IN ISRAEL/OLD JOPPA/HADERA

We will arrive in the morning at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv and go through customs and transfer to our motor coach. We will first visit the ancient port of Joppa (Jaffa), where Jonah came when fleeing from the Lord; it's also where Peter raised Dorcas from the dead and had his vision to bring the Gospel to the Gentiles at the house of Simon the Tanner. We will enjoy a fish lunch there in Joppa. Then, on to our hotel in Hadera on the beautiful Mediterranean Sea!

FEB 20 FRI CAESAREA MARITIMA/MT. CARMEL/TEL ME-GIDDO/MT. PRECIPICE/OVERVIEW NAZARETH/SEA OF GALILEE

We begin the day by traveling along the Sharon Valley to Caesarea to visit the Roman theatre. Caesarea was the resort of Roman officials, such as Pontius Pilate, and was also the place of the prison of the Apostle Paul and where Paul appeared before the Roman officials. The next stop will be Mount Carmel with its magnificent view of the Valley of Armageddon (the Jezreel Valley) and where Elijah had his confrontation with the prophets of Baal and proved that "the Lord, He is God!" Continue along the coast to Megiddo (Armageddon of Revelation). See the excavations, King Solomon's stables and King Ahab's water tunnel. Next, to Nazareth, Jesus' boyhood home, and go to the precipice overlooking Nazareth, where Jesus was carried to the top and threatened to be thrown over the cliff. Then, on to our hotel on the beautiful Sea of Galilee!

FEB 21 SAT CHORAZIM/TEL HAZOR/TEL DAN/CAESAREA PHILIPPI/

GOLAN HEIGHTS/DAMASCUS ROAD/MAGDALA/SEA OF GALILEE We begin the day at the ruins of Chorazin, one of the three cities which Jesus predicted would be destroyed. Then, we will visit Tel Hazor, the ancient City conquered by Joshua. The next stop will be the fascinating Tel Dan where the ancient Old Testament city of Dan was located. Then travel on to Banias (Caesarea Philippi) and see one of the three sources of the Jordan River and where Peter made his great confession, "Thou art the Christ, the son of the Living God." Then, we will be traveling on part of the famous Damascus Road where Paul experienced his dramatic conversion experience. Next, we go to Magdala, the home of Mary Magdalene and see the synagogue where Jesus would have visited and other interesting sites there by the Sea of Galilee. Then, we go to our hotel on the Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight.

FEB 22 SUN BOAT RIDE ON THE SEA OF GALILEE/ JESUS' BOAT MUSEUM/ MOUNT OF BEATITUDES/TAGHHA (THE SEVEN SPRINGS)/CAPERNAUM/THE GOSPEL TRAIL/BAPTISM IN THE

JORDAN RIVER AT YARDENIT/SEA OF GALILEE

We will begin the day with a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee, where we will have a worship service in the middle of the Sea — one of the highlights of the trip! We will next visit the Jesus Boat museum and see an authentic first century fishing boat (could it have been the one Jesus and His disciples used?). Next, we go to the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus preached the "Sermon on the Mount". There, we will enjoy a magnificent view of the Sea of Galilee and read the Beatitudes. Then, visit Taghba, site of the miracle of the loaves and fish, and also where Jesus fed His disciples a meal on the beach of the Sea of Galilee after His resurrection, and where Jesus restored Peter (John 21); next, a visit to Capernaum, with its synagogue and the house of Simon Peter, where Jesus ministered and performed many miracles. Next, we will walk on a portion of the Gospel Trail at the Valley of the Doves by the Sea of Galilee, the exact route Jesus would have traveled when he came to the Sea of Galilee area. We will end the day with a baptism service in the Jordan River; and then arrive back at our hotel on the shores of the Sea of Galilee.

FEB 23 MON GADARA (KURSI)/SUSSITA (HIPPOS)/BEIT SHE'AN—SCYTHOPOLIS/BETH ABARA (THE PLACE OF THE CROSSING AND THE BAPTISM OF JESUS/UP TO JERUSALEM!

We begin the day with a visit to Gadara (the land of the Gadarenes), where Jesus made whole the man possessed with demons when He cast out the swine (Mark 5); Next, we go to Sussita (Hippos), one of the Decapolis cities, overlooking the beautiful Sea of Galilee; we then will travel to Beit Sh'ean (Scythopolis), another one of the Decapolis cities, where Saul's and Jonathan's heads were nailed to the walls of that city; Next, we will visit Beth Abara, the portion of the Jordan River where Joshua crossed with the children of Israel and also the place where John the Baptist baptized Jesus; Then, excitement is mounting as we begin our ascent to Jerusalem. When we arrive, our first stop will be Mount Scopus for an overlook of the beautiful City of Jerusalem! Dinner and overnight in our hotel in Jerusalem, the City of God!

FEB 24 TUE MOUNT OF OLIVES/THE PALM SUNDAY ROAD/ DOMINUS FLEVIT CHURCH (THE LORD WEPT)/GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE/ST. PETER IN GALlicantu (HOUSE OF CAIPHAS)/UPPER ROOM/DAVID'S TOMB/SHEPHERD'S FIELDS/ AMERICAN EMBASSY/OVERNIGHT IN JERUSALEM

The first thing today, we will go to the top of the Mt. of Olives and see the magnificent view over the City of Jerusalem and the Temple area. Then, we will take the Palm Sunday route down the Mt. of Olives, stopping at Dominus Flavit, the place where Jesus wept over Jerusalem, and then on to the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed, and where you too will be able to pray. Enjoy a visit to the Church of All Nations. Next, we will visit St. Peter in Gallicantu, the home of Caiphas the High Priest, where Peter denied Jesus in the courtyard, and where it is believed Jesus spent the night before His crucifixion (a fulfillment of prophecy of Psalm 88). next, we will go to the Upper Room and visit in the area where the Last Supper was held; then, a visit to David's Tomb. Then, we will look over Shepherd's Field near Bethlehem. We will end the day with a visit to the American Embassy in Jerusalem. Next, return to our hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

FEB 25 WED JERUSALEM/TEMPLE MOUNT/WESTERN WALL/ ARCHAEOLOGICAL PARK (SOUTHERN STEPS OF TEMPLE)/CITY OF DAVID/POOL OF SILOAM/JEWISH QUARTER/WESTERN WALL TOUR/

OVERNIGHT IN JERUSALEM

We begin our day by entering the Old City of Jerusalem. We will then go to Temple Mount, where the Temple of Jesus' day once stood, and be amazed at the size and magnitude of the temple complex; Then, a visit to the Western (or Wailing) Wall, where we will visit the remains of the temple wall from the time of Jesus; there, you can place your prayer requests in the crevices of the wall as countless others have done in the past. Next, we will visit the Archaeological Park where a first century street, trumpeting stone and southern steps of the Temple can still be seen as they were at time of destruction of Jerusalem in 70 AD. Then, we will visit the City of David where King David ruled; also, visit the amazing ruins of the Pool of Siloam where Jesus healed the blind man. Next, we will visit the Jewish Quarter and tour the Western Wall underground to see history come alive! We will end the day with dinner and overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem.

FEB 26 THU MASADA/EIN-GEDI/QUMRAN/DEAD SEA/ KALIA BEACH/DRIVE THROUGH THE VALLEY OF THE SHADOW OF DEATH/OVERNIGHT IN JERUSALEM

This morning we will travel along the Dead Sea until we reach the amazing complex of Masada, where we will travel by cable car to reach the top of this fascinating fortress of King Herod, and also where religious zealots took their lives rather than surrender to slavery. Then we will go to the spring and oasis of Ein-Gedi, where David hid from Saul. Next, on to Qumran on the shores of the Dead Sea, where the Dead Sea scrolls were found — the greatest archaeological discovery thus far in the history of Israel. We will then stop on the shores of the Dead Sea for a float in the Dead Sea for those who would like; others can enjoy relaxing there. On the way back to Jerusalem, we will drive through the Valley of the Shadow of Death, the place David referred to in his 23rd Psalm. Then on the Jerusalem for dinner and overnight at our hotel.

FEB 27 FRI ST. ANNE'S CHURCH/POOL OF BETHESDA/ ECCE HOMO (PILATE'S JUDGMENT HALL)/VIA DOLAROSA THROUGH DAMASCUS GATE/GARDEN TOMB/ELAH VALLEY/ THE ROAD TO EMMAUS/ FAREWELL DINNER/OVERNIGHT IN JERUSALEM

We begin the day by going to St. Anne's Church, known for its amazing acoustics; next, to the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the lame man; then, on to Pilates' Judgment Hall and pavement area (Ecce Homo), where Jesus was beaten and the cross was placed on His back. We will then follow the route of Jesus on the day of His crucifixion, going through the Damascus Gate to the Garden Tomb for a worship and communion service to celebrate the fact that He is risen! Next, we will travel to the Valley of Elah and see the same area where David killed Goliath; you might want to pick up five smooth stones out of the brook there as a remembrance of your visit. Our next visit is to the Road of Emmaus, where Jesus appeared to two of His disciples after his crucifixion and resurrection and offered them encouragement and hope. Next, we will have a farewell dinner where we will enjoy food and fellowship with one another. Overnight in our hotel in Jerusalem
